A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 10-1-791 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 consumer fees to implement provisions of Article 28, relating to the "Georgia Lemon Law,"
- 3 and enforcement, so as to increase the fee to be collected by new motor vehicle dealers from
- 4 the consumer for the sale or lease of a new motor vehicle; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 provide an for effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 10-1-791 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to consumer fees
- 10 to implement provisions of Article 28, relating to the "Georgia Lemon Law," and
- 11 enforcement, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 12 "(a) A fee of \$3.00 \$5.00 shall be collected by the new motor vehicle dealer from the
- 13 consumer at completion of a sale or execution of a lease of each new motor vehicle. The
- 14 fee shall be forwarded quarterly to the Office of Planning and Budget for deposit in the
- 15 new motor vehicle arbitration account created in the state treasury. The payments are due
- and payable the first day of the month in each quarter for the previous quarter's collection
- and shall be mailed by the new motor vehicle dealer not later than the twentieth day of such
- month. The first day of the month in each quarter is July 1, October 1, January 1, and April
- 19 1 for each year. Consumer fees in the account shall be used for the purposes of this article.
- Funds in excess of the appropriated amount remaining in the new motor vehicle arbitration
- account at the end of each fiscal year shall be transferred to the general treasury. The new
- motor vehicle dealer shall retain \$1.00 of each fee collected to cover administrative costs."
- SECTION 2.
- 24 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012, and apply to vehicles sold or leased on or
- after such date.
