## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the 4-H Clubs of Georgia and declaring February 6, 2012, 4-H Day at the  
2 capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, 4-H members consistently demonstrate the ability and leadership necessary to  
4 be champions and serve as outstanding representatives and officers of the young people of  
5 Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Dowdy White of Crisp County serves with distinction and dedication as  
7 State 4-H President; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Arch D. Smith of the University of Georgia Cooperative Extension and  
9 State 4-H Leader has worked diligently with the 4-H Clubs throughout Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, the leadership, dedication, and hard work of James Hicks of Butts County,  
11 Quinten Brasher of Chattooga County, Brandon Cherry of Jenkins County, and A.J. Wells  
12 of Marion County as district presidents have been acknowledged by the 4-H membership in  
13 their election of each of these young people to serve as president for 2011-2012; and

14 WHEREAS, the excellent record of accomplishments in citizenship and leadership of Lauren  
15 Morris of Oconee County, Matthew Pace of Chattooga County, Katlyn LaVelle of Spalding  
16 County, and Will Walker of Turner County were recognized in Washington, D.C., at the  
17 2011 National 4-H Conference; and

18 WHEREAS, Morgan Bowen of Sumter County and Crystal Buckingham of Pickens County  
19 were named 2011 Leadership in Action Winners; and

20 WHEREAS, Tiffany Garrett of Madison County, Clay Hurdle of Lowndes County, Juawn  
21 Jackson of Bibb County, Josh Norton of Rockdale County, and Amanda Starling of  
22 Effingham County were named state winners in the 2011 Dean's Awards competition; and

23 WHEREAS, Tess Hammock of Monroe County won the 2011 National Chicken BBQ  
24 Contest in Louisville, Kentucky; and

25 WHEREAS, the Tift County Poultry Judging Team composed of Conor Dunn, Anna  
26 Johnson, Sara Johnson, and DeAnn Taylor won the 2011 National Poultry Judging Contest  
27 in Louisville, Kentucky, and Conor Dunn was named High Individual in the national contest;

29 WHEREAS, the Hart County Forestry Judging Team composed of Brittany Evans, Abby  
30 Harrison, Ashley Hollinshead, and Rachel Rice won the 2011 National 4-H Forestry  
31 Invitational in Weston, West Virginia; and

32 WHEREAS, Monday, February 6, 2012, is 4-H Day at the state capitol.

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
34 recognize and commend the University of Georgia College of Agriculture and Environmental  
35 Sciences 4-H Program; Mr. Dowdy White, State 4-H President; Mr. Arch D. Smith, State  
36 4-H Leader; and each of the 2011-2012 4-H district presidents, 2011 Dean's Awards winners,  
37 2011 4-H Conference delegates, 2011 Leadership in Action winners, the 2011 National  
38 Chicken BBQ Contest winner, the 2011 National Poultry Judging Contest winners, and the  
39 2011 national winners in the National 4-H Forestry Invitational for their numerous  
40 accomplishments and for the leadership which they have demonstrated and declare February  
41 6, 2012, as 4-H Day at the capitol.
