A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Morrow Mayor James "Jim" Millirons on the occasion of his
2 retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mayor James "Jim" Millirons has diligently and conscientiously devoted
4 innumerable hours of his time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community
5 and state as evidenced dramatically by his superlative service during 16 years as Mayor of
6 Morrow and his involvement in his city's government since the 1970's; and

7 WHEREAS, united in love and marriage to Peggy for 35 years, Mayor Millirons will enjoy
8 his retirement spending time with his wife and writing, doing genealogical research, and
9 remaining somehow involved in politics; and

10 WHEREAS, Mayor Millirons's retirement brings an end to more than three decades of public
11 service in Morrow; and

12 WHEREAS, he was the city manager from 1975-1983, a city councilman from 1987-1995,
13 and mayor from 1996-2011; and

14 WHEREAS, he served for 24 years as a helicopter pilot in the U.S. Army where he earned
15 numerous awards including the Silver Star, the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, and three
16 Distinguished Flying Crosses; and

17 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
18 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this
19 state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

20 WHEREAS, Mayor James "Jim" Millirons has long been recognized by the citizens of this
21 state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to
22 the welfare of the citizens of Georgia.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 recognize Mayor James "Jim" Millirons for his outstanding career and commend him for his
25 years of service as Mayor of Morrow.
