## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Concerned Black Citizens Coalition; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Concerned Black Citizens Coalition has sponsored the Martin Luther King  
4 Celebration in Clayton County, an annual celebration that has been held for the Clayton  
5 County Ecumenical Service, for the past 27 years; and

6 WHEREAS, the Concerned Black Citizens Coalition is a civic organization in Clayton  
7 County dedicated to improving the quality of life for the citizens of the community; and

8 WHEREAS, the organization is committed to civil rights and social justice and has held  
9 political forums and community forums to inform the citizens of key issues that affect the  
10 community; and

11 WHEREAS, the Concerned Black Citizens Coalition spearheaded the effort to have a school  
12 named in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and worked until that effort became a reality;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the coalition's significant organizational and leadership talents and sensitivity  
15 to the needs of the citizens of its community have earned it respect and admiration; and

16 WHEREAS, the dedicated efforts and amazing work of the Concerned Black Citizens  
17 Coalition is worthy of recognition.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
19 commend the Concerned Black Citizens Coalition for its outstanding services in Clayton  
20 County and extend to it sincere best wishes for the future.
