- 4 WHEREAS, Sophie Sydney Moore was born on November 9, 1914, in Philadelphia,
5 Pennsylvania, a beloved daughter of Joseph and Frances Wing; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Sophie was an active member of St. Simon,
7 the Cyrenian Episcopal Church in Philadelphia until she moved to Stone Mountain, Georgia,
8 in 1988 and became connected with Antioch A.M.E. church; and

10 was blessed with three remarkable children, Jacqueline, Theodore, and Wayne; and
- 11 WHEREAS, she believed in serving her community and during her 25 years of service with
12 the federal government, she received several awards for her accomplishments, service, and
13 innovations of workload improvements; and
- 14 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
15 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,
16 she made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 17 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Sophie Sydney Moore will long be
18 remembered for her love of family and friendship, and this loyal mother, wife, and friend will
19 be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.
