A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Sequoyah High School; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Sequoyah High School has been named a State Exemplary High School Library
3 Media Program for 2011; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Jan Reed and Eleese Franchini are the library media specialists at Sequoyah
5 High School; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Georgia's Exemplary Library Media Program was established in 2002 to honor
7 outstanding library media programs each year at the elementary, middle, and high school
8 levels; and
- 9 WHEREAS, seven schools in Georgia received exemplary awards for their media programs
10 for 2011, and Sequoyah was selected one of the two high school programs recognized in the
11 state; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the State Board Recognition Program is an initiative of the Educational
13 Technology and Media Unit that includes a written application, a principal's narrative, and
14 interviews that describe how the library media program is meeting school improvement goals
15 and increasing student achievement; and
- 16 WHEREAS, scoring is based on laws, policies, and standards set by the Georgia legislature,
17 the State Board of Education, and the American Association of School Librarians; and
- 18 WHEREAS, this year's winners will be recognized at the Georgia Educational Technology
19 Conference; and

20 WHEREAS, Sequoyah High School represents the true spirit of leadership, responsibility,
21 and achievement, and the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation to the future of this
22 bright and promising high school.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend Sequoyah High School and extend congratulations for being recognized as a State
25 Exemplary High School Library Media Program for 2011.
