A RESOLUTION

4 WHEREAS, 4-H members consistently demonstrate the ability and leadership necessary to
5 be champions and serve as outstanding representatives and officers of the young people of
6 Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Dowdy White of Crisp County serves with distinction and dedication as
8 State 4-H President; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Arch D. Smith of the University of Georgia Cooperative Extension and 4-H
10 and Youth Development State Program Leader has worked diligently with the 4-H Clubs
11 throughout Georgia; and

12 WHEREAS, the leadership, dedication, and hard work of James Hicks of Butts County,
13 Quinten Brasher of Chattooga County, Brandon Cherry of Jenkins County, and A.J. Wells
14 of Marion County as district presidents have been acknowledged by the 4-H membership in
15 its election of each of these young people to serve as presidents for 2011-2012; and

16 WHEREAS, the excellent record of accomplishments in citizenship and leadership of Lauren
17 Morris of Oconee County, Matthew Pace of Chattooga County, Katlyn LaVelle of Spalding
18 County, and Will Walker of Turner County, was recognized in Washington, D.C. at the 2011
19 National 4-H Conference; and

20 WHEREAS, Morgan Bowen of Sumter County and Crystal Buckingham of Pickens County
21 were named 2011 Leadership in Action Winners; and

22 WHEREAS, Tiffany Garrett of Madison County, Clay Hurdle of Lowndes County, Juawn
23 Jackson of Bibb County, Josh Norton of Rockdale County, and Amanda Starling of
24 Effingham County were named state winners in the 2011 Dean's Awards competition; and

25 WHEREAS, Tess Hammock of Monroe County won the 2011 National Chicken BBQ
26 Contest in Louisville, Kentucky; and

27 WHEREAS, the Tift County Poultry Judging Team composed of Conor Dunn, Anna
28 Johnson, Sara Johnson, and DeAnn Taylor won the 2011 National Poultry Judging Contest
29 in Louisville, Kentucky, and Conor Dunn was named High Individual in the national contest;

31 WHEREAS, the Hart County Forestry Judging Team composed of Brittany Evans, Abby
32 Harrison, Ashley Hollinshead, and Rachel Rice won the 2011 National 4-H Forestry
33 Invitational in Weston, West Virginia.

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
35 the members of this body recognize February 6, 2012, as 4-H Day at the capitol, commend
36 the University of Georgia College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences 4-H
37 Programs, Mr. Dowdy White, State 4-H Club President, Mr. Arch D. Smith, State 4-H
38 Leader, and each of the 2011-2012 district presidents, 2011 National 4-H Conference
39 delegates, 2011 Leadership in Action Winners, 2011 Dean's Awards Winners, the 2011
40 National Chicken BBQ Contest Winner, the 2011 National Poultry Judging Contest Winners,
41 and the 2011 National Winners in the National 4-H Forestry Invitational, for their numerous
42 accomplishments, and for the leadership which they have demonstrated and invite each of
43 the 4-H leaders and members to be recognized by the House of Representatives at a date and
44 time to be determined by the Speaker of the House.
