A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Baldwin County Mayor's Commission on Youth
2 Leadership and the High Achievers Program; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Baldwin County Mayor's Commission on Youth Leadership was established
4 to enable students in Baldwin County to develop civic knowledge of their county and
5 community and teach them to apply the civic skills of organizing, communicating, and
6 working with others; and
