

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE LOCAL LEGISLATION

Notice is given that there will be introduced at the regular 2012 session of the General Assembly of Georgia a bill to amend an Act providing for the election of the members of the Board of Education of Baldwin County, approved April 3, 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 3325), as amended, specifically by an Act approved April 25, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, 4230), so as to change the description of the education districts; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to provide for continuation in office of current members; to provide for election and terms of office of subsequent members; to provide for submission of the Act for approval under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to provide effective dates; and for other purposes.
