

Senate Bill 338

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 43-11-52 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2 "Georgia Volunteers in Dentistry and Dental Hygiene Act," so as to provide for special
3 licenses for dentists and dental hygienists licensed in other jurisdictions; to provide for
4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Code Section 43-11-52 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the "Georgia
8 Volunteers in Dentistry and Dental Hygiene Act," is amended by revising subsection (b) as
9 follows:

10 "(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the board shall issue a special license to
11 qualifying dentists and dental hygienists under the terms and conditions set forth in this
12 Code section and pursuant to requirements which may be set forth in the rules and
13 regulations of the board. The special license shall only be issued to a person who:

14 (1) ~~Is~~ is retired from the practice of dentistry or dental hygiene and not currently engaged
15 in such practice either full time or part time and has, prior to retirement, maintained full
16 unrestricted licensure in good standing in dentistry or dental hygiene in any state; or

17 (2) Is currently licensed to practice dentistry or dental hygiene in any licensing
18 jurisdiction in the United States and whose license is unrestricted and in good standing.

19 As used in this subsection, the term 'unrestricted' means that no restrictions have been
20 placed on the applicant's license by ~~the~~ any board, no sanctions or disciplinary actions have
21 been imposed by ~~the~~ any board on the applicant, and the applicant is not under probation
22 or suspension by ~~the~~ any board."

23 SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
