## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Article 15 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2	relating to serious traffic offenses, so as to provide for expungement of a conviction for
3	driving under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or other intoxicating substances under certain
4	circumstances; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
5	purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Article 15 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9	serious traffic offenses, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
10	″ <u>40-6-391.4.</u>
11	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person convicted of violating Code
12	Section 40-6-391 who is not subsequently convicted of a violation of any offense under this
13	title for which points are assessed within five years, as measured from the date of the arrest
14	for which a conviction was obtained or a plea of nolo contendere was accepted, shall have
15	such conviction permanently expunged and completely removed from his or her criminal
16	and driving record."
17	SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 18
