

## Senate Resolution 730

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the destructive and insidious nature of the United Nations Agenda 21; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the United Nations Agenda 21 is a comprehensive plan of extreme  
4 environmentalism, social engineering, and global political control that was initiated at the  
5 United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED) held in Rio de  
6 Janeiro, Brazil, in 1992; and

7 WHEREAS, the United Nations Agenda 21 is being covertly pushed into local communities  
8 throughout the United States of America through the International Council of Local  
9 Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI) through local "sustainable development" policies, such as  
10 Smart Growth, Wildlands Project, Resilient Cities, Regional Visioning Projects, and other  
11 "Green" or "Alternative" projects; and

12 WHEREAS, this plan of radical so-called "sustainable development" views the American  
13 way of life of private property ownership, single-family homes, private car ownership and  
14 individual travel choices, and privately owned farms all as destructive to the environment;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS, according to the United Nations Agenda 21 policy, social justice is described  
17 as the right and opportunity of all people to benefit equally from the resources afforded by  
18 society and the environment which would be accomplished by socialists and communist  
19 redistribution of wealth; and

20 WHEREAS, according to the United Nations Agenda 21 policy, national sovereignty is  
21 deemed a social injustice.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
23 recognize the destructive and insidious nature of the United Nations Agenda 21, endorse

24 rejection of its radical policies and of any grant monies attached to it, and recommend  
25 exposing to the public and public policymakers the dangerous intent of the plan.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
27 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the public and the press.
