A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to school attendance in elementary and secondary education, so as to
- 3 enact the "Dropout Deterrent Act"; to provide for a short title; to revise the age of mandatory
- 4 education; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

8 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Dropout Deterrent Act."

9 SECTION 2.

- 10 Part 1 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- relating to school attendance in elementary and secondary education, is amended by revising
- subsection (a) of Code Section 20-2-690.1, relating to mandatory education for children, as
- 13 follows:
- 14 "(a) Mandatory attendance in a public school, private school, or home school program shall
- be required for children between their sixth and sixteenth seventeenth birthdays. Such
- mandatory attendance shall not be required where the child has successfully completed all
- 17 requirements for a high school diploma."
- SECTION 3.
- 19 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012.
- SECTION 4.
- 21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
