## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 20-2-751.7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	the process for students to follow in reporting instances of alleged inappropriate behavior by
3	teachers, so as to eliminate a time frame relative to hearings before administrative law
4	judges; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 20-2-751.7 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the process
8	for students to follow in reporting instances of alleged inappropriate behavior by teachers,

9 is amended by revising paragraph (3) of subsection (d) as follows:

10 "(3) If the Professional Standards Commission's review of the investigative report results in a sanction against the educator, the educator shall have the right to appeal the 11 12 commission decision to a hearing before an administrative law judge within 90 days of such sanction." 13
