A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 2 of Title 18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the
- 2 "Uniform Fraudulent Transfers Act," so as to define certain terms; to provide that a charitable
- 3 contribution made to a charitable organization shall not be deemed a fraudulent transfer
- 4 where the charitable organization receives such contribution in good faith; to provide for
- 5 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 4 of Chapter 2 of Title 18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Uniform
- 9 Fraudulent Transfers Act," is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>18-2-81.</u>
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 12 (1) 'Charitable contribution' means the grant of any money or property of any kind or
- value to a charitable organization.
- 14 (2) 'Charitable organization' means a religious, benevolent, philanthropic, patriotic, or
- eleemosynary organization qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue
- 16 Code of 1986, as now or hereafter amended.
- 17 (3) 'Good faith' means the receipt of a charitable contribution under circumstances where
- the receiving charitable organization had no knowledge that such transfer was made
- 19 <u>fraudulently within the meaning of this article.</u>
- 20 (b) A charitable contribution made to a charitable organization shall not be considered a
- 21 <u>fraudulent transfer and shall not be subject to avoidance, attachment, recapture, or other</u>
- 22 relief where a charitable organization receives such contribution in good faith."

SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
