# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Toombs County, approved 2 February 13, 1959 (Ga. L. 1959, p. 2010), as amended, particularly by an Act approved 3 March 23, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 3927), and an Act approved April 28, 2006 (Ga. L. 2006, 4 p. 3808), so as to reconstitute the board of commissioners; to change the description of the 5 commissioner districts; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to provide for continuation in office of current members; to provide for election and terms of office of subsequent 6 7 members; to provide for submission of this Act for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; 8 9 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

# SECTION 1. An Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Toombs County, approved February 13, 1959 (Ga. L. 1959, p. 2010), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 23, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 3927), and an Act approved April 28, 2006 (Ga. L. 2006, p. 3808), is amended by striking Sections 1 through 3(A) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16 "SECTION 1.
17 The Board of Commissioners of Toombs County which existed on December 31, 2011, is
18 continued in existence but on and after the effective date of this Act shall be constituted as
19 provided in this Act. The Board of Commissioners of Toombs County so continued and
20 constituted, sometimes referred to in this Act as the 'board,' shall continue to have the
21 powers, duties, rights, obligations, and liabilities of that board as existed immediately prior
22 to the effective date of this Act.

# **SECTION 2.**

24 (a) Those members of the Board of Commissioners of Toombs County who are serving 25 as such on December 31, 2011, and any person selected to fill a vacancy in any such office 26 shall continue to serve as such members until the regular expiration of their respective 27 terms of office and upon the election and qualification of their respective successors. On 28 and after the effective date of this Act, the Board of Commissioners of Toombs County 29 shall consist of four members who shall be elected from commissioner districts described 30 in subsection (b) of this section and a chairperson who is elected at large as provided in 31 subsection (c) of Section 3 of this Act.

32 (b) For purposes of electing members of the board of commissioners other than the chairperson, Toombs County is divided into four commissioner districts. One member of 33 34 the board shall be elected from each such district. The four commissioner districts shall be and correspond to those four numbered districts described in and attached to and made 35 a part of this Act and further identified as 'Plan Name: toombscc-2012 Plan Type: Local 36 37 Administrator: Toombs User: bak'.

38 (c) When used in such attachment, the term 'VTD' shall mean and describe the same 39 geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the 40 United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia. The separate numeric 41 designations in a district description which are underneath a 'VTD' heading shall mean and 42 describe individual Blocks within a VTD as provided in the report of the Bureau of the 43 Census for the United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.

44 (d) Any part of Toombs County which is not included in any such district described in the 45 attachment shall be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of 46 47 Georgia. Any part of Toombs County which is described in the attachment as being in a 48 particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such district if such part is not 49 contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall instead be included within that 50 district contiguous to such part which contains the least population according to the United 51 States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia. (e) Except as otherwise provided in the description of any commissioner district, whenever 52 the description of such district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical 53

54 boundaries of that city as shown on the census map for the United States decennial census

of 2010 for the State of Georgia. 55

### SECTION 3.

(a) No person shall be a member of the board if that person is ineligible for such office
pursuant to Code Section 45-2-1 of the O.C.G.A. or any other general law applicable to that
office.

(b) In order to be elected or appointed as a member of the board from a commissioner 60 61 district, a person must have that person's legal residence in that district at the time of 62 qualifying for election or at the time of appointment and, if elected, must receive the number of votes cast as required by general law for that office in that district only and not 63 64 at large. Only electors who are residents of that commissioner district may vote for a 65 member of the board for that district. At the time of qualifying for election as a member of the board from a commissioner district, each candidate for such office shall specify the 66 67 commissioner district for which that person is a candidate. A person elected or appointed 68 as a member of the board from a commissioner district must continue to reside in that 69 district during that person's term of office or that office shall become vacant.

(c) The chairperson of the board may reside anywhere within Toombs County and, if
elected, must receive the number of votes cast for that office as required by general law in
the entire county. The chairperson must continue to reside within the county during that
person's term of office or that office shall become vacant.

### SECTION 3A.

75 (a) The members of the reconstituted Board of Commissioners of Toombs County shall 76 be elected as provided in this subsection. The first members from Commissioner 77 Districts 1 and 4 shall be elected at the general election on the Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2014. Those members of the board elected thereto from 78 79 Commissioner Districts 1 and 4 in 2014 shall take office the first day of January 80 immediately following that election and shall serve for initial terms of office which expire 81 December 31, 2018, and upon the election and qualification of their respective successors. The first members from Commissioner Districts 2 and 3 and the at-large district shall be 82 83 elected at the general election on the Tuesday next following the first Monday in 84 November, 2012. Those members of the board elected thereto from Commissioner Districts 2 and 3 and the at-large district in 2012 shall take office the first day of January 85 86 immediately following that election and shall serve for initial terms of office which expire December 31, 2016, and upon the election and qualification of their respective successors. 87 Those and all future successors to members of the board whose terms of office are to expire 88 shall be elected at the time of the state-wide general election immediately preceding the 89 90 expiration of such terms, shall take office the first day of January immediately following 91 that election, and shall serve for terms of office of four years each. Members of the board

- 92 shall serve for the terms of office specified therefor in this subsection and until their93 respective successors are elected and qualified.
- 94 (b) All members of the board who are elected thereto shall be nominated and elected in
  95 accordance with Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia Election Code.'

96 (c) Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4, as they existed on December 31, 2011, shall 97 continue to be designated as Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4, respectively, but as 98 newly described under this Act, and on and after the effective date of this Act, such 99 members of the board serving from those former commissioner districts shall be deemed 100 to be serving from and representing their respective districts as newly described under this

101 Act."

# **SECTION 2.**

The Board of Commissioners of Toombs County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; and such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with the appropriate court no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

- 109 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012.

111 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
