- 4 WHEREAS, Pamela L. Tremayne had a vibrant personality in Atlanta for 40-some years;

- 6 WHEREAS, she moved upward in her pursuits both professionally, as an attorney, and as
7 a devoted volunteer; and
- 8 WHEREAS, she was a leader and held positions for the Atlanta Bar Association and the
9 State Bar of Georgia, long served as the president of the International Club of Atlanta, and
10 was a board member of Big Brothers/Big Sisters; and
- 11 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
12 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,
13 she made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Pamela L. Tremayne received numerous degrees, earning her Bachelor of Arts
15 degree in sociology, her Master's degree in Latin American studies, and her Ph.D. in
16 sociology; and
- 17 WHEREAS, she will always be remembered for her balance of life and always giving back
18 to the community and represented a true inspiration to building a greater community.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 join in honoring the life and memory of Pamela L. Tremayne and express their deepest and
21 most sincere regret at her passing.
