### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Dub Jones; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of longtime retired Hall County educator  
3 Dub Jones; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Dub Jones was born on July 10, 1925, in Banks County and was a beloved  
5 father of five children, Duane, Dwight, Denise, Debra, and Dalva; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he graduated from Air Line High School and Piedmont College, then went on  
7 to George Peabody College in Tennessee where he received an advanced degree in  
8 education; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Dub Jones was known as an accomplished athlete in industrial league baseball  
10 and basketball and was also drafted into minor league baseball by the Detroit Tigers; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was in the Navy and served with honor and distinction by courageously  
12 protecting his fellow Americans in World War II as a radio operator; and
- 13 WHEREAS, after leaving the military, he entered the field of education and was a teacher  
14 and coach at Riverbend, East Hall, and North Hall High Schools and later served on the Hall  
15 County School Board; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Dub Jones was united in love and marriage to Louise Hopkins until her passing  
17 in 1991 and then married Geraldine Skinner who was his companion for the remainder of his  
18 life; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Dub Jones was a community servant who never met a stranger and was loved  
20 and respected by all.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
22 join in honoring the life and memory of Dub Jones and express their deepest and most  
23 sincere regret at his passing.
