A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring military veterans of the Vietnam War and commending efforts to bring a display
- 2 of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Traveling Wall to Coweta County; and for other
- 3 purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the Vietnam War lasted 20 years, from 1955 to 1975, spanning the tenures of
- 5 five United States Presidents, and the United States Department of Defense has declared
- 6 2011 as the 50th anniversary of the Vietnam War; and
- 7 WHEREAS, more than three million Americans served in the Vietnam War, with United
- 8 States troop levels increasing rapidly from the early 1960s until the country's peak
- 9 involvement in 1968, when over 550,000 soldiers were serving in Vietnam; and
- 10 WHEREAS, 58,159 members of the United States armed forces were lost in the war, and the
- 11 name of each of these heroes was inscribed on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall, which
- 12 is located on the National Mall in Washington, D.C.; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in addition to the American lives lost, there were many casualties from other
- 14 nations, including approximately three million Vietnamese soldiers and civilians, nearly
- 15 300,000 Cambodians, and approximately 200,000 Laotians; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is important that all current members of the military and veterans are thanked
- 17 for their selfless service to this nation and honored for their unyielding commitment to
- protecting the people and ideals of the United States, especially veterans of the Vietnam War,
- 19 who returned home to unpopular public opinion of the war; and
- 20 WHEREAS, on October 20-23, 2011, the Vietnam Veterans Traveling Wall will be in
- 21 Coweta County at the Coweta County Fairgrounds, giving Georgians and others the
- 22 opportunity to pay their heartfelt respect and express their deepest gratitude to those who
- 23 paid the ultimate sacrifice for our freedoms; and

24 WHEREAS, Coweta County was home to numerous military personnel who were killed in

- 25 action in Vietnam, and those currently known include Terry Allen, Jr., Johnny Calhoun,
- 26 Jessie Cofield, Tim Cole, Jr., Robert Couch, Grady Elder, Bobby Freeman, Arthur Hines,
- 27 Thomas Huddleston, Warner Hughie, James Kerr, Donald Lowery, Homer Pease, Larry
- 28 Pinson, Edgar Pittman, Jerry Smith, Leavy Solomon, William Thomas, Wayne Vessell,
- 29 Charles Walthall, Joseph Watson, and Robert M. Webb, Jr.; and
- 30 WHEREAS, veterans of the Vietnam War embody the spirit of service, willing to find
- 31 meaning in something greater than themselves, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that
- 32 the outstanding accomplishments and sacrifices of these remarkable and distinguished
- 33 Americans be honored appropriately.
- 34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 35 the members of this body recognize the selfless sacrifice of Vietnam veterans, call for
- 36 remembrance of the soldiers who have offered their lives in the name of freedom, and
- 37 commend the efforts of the Coweta County Commission on Veteran's Affairs to bring the
- 38 Traveling Wall to Georgia.
- 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 40 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Coweta County
- 41 Commission on Veteran's Affairs.
