## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Children's Advocacy Centers of Georgia and recognizing February 15, 2012,  
2 as Children's Advocacy Centers Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Children's Advocacy Centers of Georgia offers a comprehensive approach to  
4 the intervention, investigation, prosecution, and treatments of child abuse including cases  
5 involving physical abuse, neglect, sexual abuse, sexual exploitation, Internet crimes, child  
6 fatalities, and children who have witnessed domestic violence and homicides; and

7 WHEREAS, it puts the need of the children first and brings together state-of-the-art  
8 technology and experienced professionals who are trained to provide comprehensive and  
9 compassionate service to the children and their nonprofit caregivers; and

11 National Children's Alliances, Children's Advocacy Centers of Georgia truly is a leading  
12 state chapter focused on best practices in prevention, intervention, and treatment of child  
13 abuse; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding work of this fine  
15 organization and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be appropriately  
16 recognized.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body commend the Children's Advocacy Centers of Georgia for their  
19 dedicated efforts in prevention, intervention, and treatment of child abuse and recognize
