14 where he enrolled to receive the very best training necessary to acquire the knowledge and
15 skills that would afford him a secure future in his chosen profession; and

16 WHEREAS, in pursuing his education, Alvie brought honor to himself, his family, Ogeechee
17 Technical College, and the entire Technical College System of Georgia, which he represents
18 as Georgia's outstanding technical college student for 2011; and

19 WHEREAS, he personifies the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness, and
20 personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and
