A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions for law enforcement officers and agencies, so as to mandate certain
- 3 conduct when a person is reported missing; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 8 provisions for law enforcement officers and agencies, is amended by adding a new Code
- 9 section to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>35-1-18.</u>
- 11 Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, if a family member reports a
- 12 person missing, and a law enforcement officer locates the missing person's vehicle and the
- missing person is not inside of the vehicle but the vehicle is running, the law enforcement
- officer shall report this information to the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, and the bureau
- shall commence an investigation to locate the missing person."

SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
