

## Senate Resolution 828

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and condemning the effect of the Affordable Care Act on the American  
2 Catholic Church; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Affordable Care Act consists of individual mandate provisions that force  
4 people to buy insurance or pay a penalty tax for not doing so; and

5 WHEREAS, the law entails that all health plans provide preventive services which now  
6 include child vaccinations, physical check-ups, and other practical medical services that  
7 some people do not want from time to time; and

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services announced that the final rule on  
9 preventive health services will ensure that women with health insurance coverage will have  
10 access to full range of the Institute of Medicine's recommended preventive services,  
11 including all FDA approved forms of contraception; and

12 WHEREAS, the mandate was not supposed to be enforced against the various services and  
13 schools run by the American Catholic Church, but the Administration has since stated that  
14 as of August 1, 2012, they must also comply with the new law; and

15 WHEREAS, the Catholic belief is that an unborn child is a fully-corporate, living human  
16 being; and

17 WHEREAS, the Church states that abortion, kinetic or chemical, terminates the life of a  
18 human being and violates the Sixth Commandment, making the Church morally culpable for  
19 every abortion taking place under the insurance plan; and

20 WHEREAS, the American Catholic Church is reaching out in an attempt to hold onto their  
21 First Amendment rights, as well as their belief and religion.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
23 recognize and condemn the effects on the American Catholic Church by the Affordable Care  
24 Act's newly mandated law.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
26 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the public and the press.
