A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Susan Redmon, the 2012 Commerce Elementary School
2 Teacher of the Year and Commerce City Schools Teacher of the Year; and for other
3 purposes.

7 of Science degree in early childhood education and a master's degree in early childhood
8 education from Brenau College; and

10 where she taught third grade for 16 years, before joining Commerce Elementary School in
11 2000, where she has taught third grade for seven years and fourth grade for five years; and

13 School, including the Leadership Committee, Textbook Selection, RTI, SACS Committees,
14 and the School Council; and

15 WHEREAS, nothing is more vital to the future of our state than the education of our young
16 people, and Susan Redmon exemplifies the selfless dedication which is characteristic of our
17 finest educators; and

18 WHEREAS, her students consistently perform well on state assessments; in 2010, all of her
19 students either met or exceeded achievement levels in the areas of ELA, math, reading, and
20 science; and

21 WHEREAS, she is a highly respected educator in the Commerce City School System,
22 dedicating her time, talents, and energy to challenging and inspiring the future leaders of this
23 state; and

24 WHEREAS, the devotion to providing the students of Georgia with a quality education
25 demonstrated by Susan Redmon is worthy of recognition.

27 the members of this body commend heartily Susan Redmon, the 2012 Commerce Elementary
