A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the men of Hidden Lake subdivision; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the men of Hidden Lake subdivision have long been recognized by the citizens
3 of this state for the vital role that they have played in leadership and for their deep personal
4 commitment to the welfare of their community and the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the men of Hidden Lake subdivision have committed their time, effort, and hard
6 work to the enhancement of their neighborhood and furthering the goals of the subdivision;

8 WHEREAS, they worked tirelessly to clean up the landscape around the lake and
9 community, placed neighborhood signs, renovated, painted, and beautified the entrance
10 subdivision sign, removed fallen trees and other debris during inclement weather, cooked and
11 cleaned for various neighborhood functions, continuously watched out for crime and
12 corruption, attended neighborhood meetings in large numbers, and cooperatively work as
13 team members and volunteer to take leadership roles; and

14 WHEREAS, the men of Hidden Lake have a strong sense of responsibility, which serves as
15 a wonderful role model for the young children in the community and subdivision and sends
16 a powerful message to others that the community is well protected; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of
18 these distinguished Georgians be appropriately recognized.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend the men of Hidden Lake subdivision for their efficient, effective, unselfish, and
21 dedicated service to others and recognize their significant contributions to their community
22 and the State of Georgia.
