- 1 Commending the Georgia Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association and recognizing February
- 2 13, 2012, as Alzheimer's Awareness Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the mission of the Alzheimer's Association is to eliminate Alzheimer's disease
- 4 and related dementia through the advancement of research and promotion of brain health and
- 5 to enhance care and support for all individuals with Alzheimer's disease, their families, and
- 6 caregivers; and
- 7 WHEREAS, it is estimated that over 120,000 Georgians have Alzheimer's disease, and more
- 8 than 500,000 others are affected through their roles as caregivers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, there are no survivors of Alzheimer's disease; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in 2011, the Georgia Chapter served over 98,000 individuals through its
- 11 programs and services; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the Georgia Chapter's vision is a world without Alzheimer's disease, and it plans
- 13 to eliminate the disease through the advancement of research and the promotion of brain
- 14 health and to enhance care and support for all individuals, their families, and caregivers.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 16 commend the Georgia Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association for the outstanding job it is
- doing to fight Alzheimer's disease by advocating for those living with the disease and their
- 18 caregivers and recognize February 13, 2012, as Alzheimer's Awareness Day at the capitol.
