### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Miss Cherokee Rose Outstanding Teen 2012 Anna Tucker;  
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Outstanding Teen Scholarship Pageant is a sister program to the Miss  
4 America Scholarship Pageant; and

5 WHEREAS, Miss Tucker's platform is "Do Something Now," which is an Atlanta based  
6 organization that is currently partnering with several global groups to end human trafficking;

8 WHEREAS, Atlanta is the third largest hub for human trafficking in the world, and the  
9 average age of girls recruited into the sex industry in Atlanta is 14 years old; and

10 WHEREAS, Miss Tucker has been working locally with Wellspring Living to help exploited  
11 and abused women and girls get off the streets, heal, and begin again; and

12 WHEREAS, she encourages young people to get involved in small ways to make a big  
13 difference for the causes they believe in; and

14 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for  
15 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she is making of her life,  
16 she makes this world a better place in which to live; and

17 WHEREAS, the benevolent and honorable deeds of Miss Tucker serve as a shining example  
18 of a young woman, and the State of Georgia is honored and blessed to have Miss Tucker as  
19 a citizen.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
21 commend Miss Anna Tucker for her outstanding efforts and contributions and recognize her  
22 as Miss Cherokee Rose Outstanding Teen 2012.
