## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 2 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to possession of dangerous weapons, so as to define a certain term; to
- 3 provide that a political subdivision shall not enact any ordinance which is more restrictive
- 4 of the sale or possession of a knife than general law; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 2 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to possession of dangerous weapons, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 "<u>16-11-136.</u>
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'knife' means any cutting instrument with a blade
- and shall include, without limitation, a knife as such term is defined in Code Section
- 14 <u>16-11-125.1.</u>
- 15 (b) No political subdivision of this state shall, by rule or ordinance, constrain the
- possession, manufacture, sale, or transfer of a knife more restrictively than the provisions
- 17 of this part."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
