A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend an Act for the election of members of the Board of Education of Screven County,
2	approved April 1, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 3659), as amended, so as to provide for the election
3	of members of the Board of Education of Screven County; to revise the districts for the
4	election of members of the board of education; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to
5	provide for the filling of vacancies; to provide for qualifications; to provide for the election
6	of a chairperson; to provide for related matters; to provide for submission of this Act for
7	preclearance pursuant to Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to
8	provide for related matters; to provide effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
9	other purposes.
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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
11	SECTION 1.
12	An Act for the election of members of the Board of Education of Screven County, approved
13	April 1, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 3659), as amended, is amended by revising Section 1 as
14	follows:

15 "SECTION 1. (a) The Board of Education of Screven County shall be composed of seven members. For 16 the purpose of electing members of the Board of Education of Screven County, the Screven 17 18 County School District shall be divided into seven education districts. One member of the 19 board shall be elected from each district. The districts shall be and correspond to those 20 seven numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part of this Act and 21 further identified as 'Plan: screvenccsbR-2012 Plan Type: Local Administrator: Screven 22 User: Gina'. 23 (b) For purposes of such plan:

(1) The term 'VTD' shall mean and describe the same geographical boundaries as
provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census

of 2010 for the State of Georgia. The separate numeric designations in a district
description which are underneath a 'VTD' heading shall mean and describe individual
Blocks within a VTD as provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United
States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia; and

30 (2) Except as otherwise provided in the description of any district, whenever the
 31 description of such district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical
 32 boundaries of that city as shown on the census maps for the United States decennial
 33 census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.

34 (c) Any part of Screven County which is not included in any district described in
35 subsection (a) of this section shall be included within that district contiguous to such part
36 which contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of 2010
37 for the State of Georgia.

(d) Any part of Screven County which is described in subsection (a) of this section as
being included in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such district
if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall instead be
included within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least population
according to the United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia."

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SECTION 2.

44 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 2 as follows:

- 45 "SECTION 2. 46 (a) To be eligible to be elected to membership on the board of education, a person shall be a registered elector of Screven County eligible to vote for members of the General 47 48 Assembly. The members of the board of education shall be elected by the qualified 49 electors voting within their respective education districts. (b) In the event of a vacancy on the board of education for any reason other than the 50 51 expiration of the term of office, the vacancy shall be filled in accordance with the 52 provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia Election Code,' and the 53 residency requirements set forth in this Act. In the event that a member of the board of education ceases to be a resident of the education district from which such member was 54 elected, a vacancy shall exist and shall be filled in the same manner as other vacancies are 55 filled." 56
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SECTION 3.

58 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 3 as follows:

59	"SECTION 3.
60	At its first meeting each year, the members of the board of education shall elect, by
61	majority vote, one of their members to serve as chairperson for that year and until the
62	election of a chairperson in the subsequent year. A member shall be eligible to succeed
63	himself or herself as a member of the board and also as chairperson of the board."
64	SECTION 4.
65	Said Act is further amended by revising Section 4 as follows:
66	"SECTION 4.
67	(a) The members of the board of education who were elected at the general election in
68	November 2008 shall continue in office for the terms to which they were elected and until
69	successors are elected and qualified as provided in this Act. The members of the board of
70	education who were elected at the general election in November 2010 shall continue in
71	office for the terms to which they were elected and until successors are elected and
72	qualified as provided in this Act.
73	(b) The first members of the reconstituted Board of Education of Screven County from
74	Commissioner Districts 1, 4, and 7 shall be elected at the state-wide general election in
75	2014. Such members shall take office on January 1 following their election for terms of
76	four years and until their successors are elected and qualified.
77	(c) The first members of the reconstituted Board of Education of Screven County from
78	Commissioner Districts 2, 3, 5, and 6 shall be elected at the state-wide general election in
79	2012. Such members shall take office on January 1 following their election for terms of
80	four years and until their successors are elected and qualified.
81	(d) Successors to members elected under subsections (b) and (c) of this section shall be
82	elected at the state-wide general election next preceding the expiration of such terms of
83	office and shall take office on January 1 following their election for terms of four years and
84	until their successors are elected and qualified.
85	(e) Education Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 as they existed on January 1, 2012, shall
86	continue to be designated as Education Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, respectively, but as
87	newly described under this Act, and, on and after the effective date of this Act, such
88	members of the board serving from those former education districts shall be deemed to be
89	serving from and representing their respective districts as newly described under this Act.
90	(f) All members of the board of education shall be elected in nonpartisan elections as
91	provided in Code Section 21-2-139 of the O.C.G.A. Such nonpartisan elections shall be
92	conducted as provided in Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia Election
93	Code.'"

94	SECTION 5.
95	The governing authority of Screven County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to
96	be submitted for preclearance under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
97	amended, no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the Governor
98	or otherwise becomes law without such approval.
99	SECTION 6.
100	The provisions of this Act relating to and necessary for the regular election in 2012 of
101	members of the Board of Education of Screven County shall become effective upon its
102	approval by the Governor or upon its becoming effective without such approval; and this Act
103	shall otherwise become effective January 1, 2013.

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SECTION 7.

105 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
