### A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Toni Rowland for being named a 2012 Exceptional Adult Georgian in Literacy  
2 Education delegate; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Toni Rowland has been named a 2012 Exceptional Adult Georgian in Literacy  
4 Education (EAGLE) delegate for outstanding achievements and pursuit of excellence; and

5 WHEREAS, the EAGLE Program from the Technical College System of Georgia's Office  
6 of Adult Education recognizes the men and women of Georgia who have overcome life's  
7 obstacles and challenges to pursue their dream of lifelong learning; and

9 students for the EAGLE delegate competition from among more than 65,000 adult learners,
