A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 22-1-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to nature
- 2 of right of eminent domain and property to be put to public use, so as to provide that the
- 3 ownership of property seized to mitigate blight may be transferred within 20 years of the
- 4 initial condemnation; to provide that the zoning of such property cannot be changed to a
- 5 more intense use for a period of one year following condemnation; to provide for related
- 6 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 22-1-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to nature of right
- 10 of eminent domain and property to be put to public use, is amended by revising
- 11 subsection (b) as follows:
- 12 "(b) All condemnations shall not be converted to any use other than a public use for 20
- 13 years from the initial condemnation; provided, however, that, in the case of property
- 14 condemned to remedy blight, the condemnor may transfer ownership of the property at any
- 15 <u>time following the initial condemnation; and, provided, further, that in no event shall the</u>
- zoning of such property be changed to a more intense density or use than that existing at
- 17 the time of condemnation for a period of one year following the effective date of the
- 18 <u>condemnation</u>."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
