9 Chapter 9 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to mass 10 transportation, is amended by repealing in their entirety Code Sections 32-9-13 and 32-9-14, 11 relating to the suspension of restrictions on the use of annual proceeds from sales and use 12 taxes by public transit authorities and the board of directors of the Metropolitan Atlanta 13 Rapid Transit Authority, respectively.

14 SECTION 2. 15 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2013, only if an Act providing for the 16 suspension of restrictions on the use of annual proceeds from sales and use taxes by the 17 Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority and reconstituting the board of directors of the 18 Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority is enacted at the 2012 regular session of the 19 General Assembly and becomes effective on January 1, 2013. Otherwise, this Act shall not 20 become effective and shall stand repealed on January 1, 2013.
