A RESOLUTION

1 Commending University System of Georgia Outstanding Scholar Lakeisha Nashay Hampton
2 of Fort Valley State University on Academic Recognition Day for 2012; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Georgia's educational system is dedicated to the goal of providing a quality
5 education to all and fostering the realization of each person's fullest potential; and

6 WHEREAS, the 35 institutions of the University System of Georgia are valuable resources
7 for the people of this state, enhancing the intellectual, economic, social, civic, and cultural
