A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and honoring Georgia Guard soldiers and airmen and others who have fallen
2 during Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, with December 15, 2011, marking the end of the Iraq War, we have reached a
4 point of reflection in the long conflict against terrorism; and

5 WHEREAS, though the war on terrorism continues, we are pausing to reflect on the sacrifice
6 of those Georgia Guard soldiers and airmen and others who have lost their lives during
7 Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom; and

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
28 honor the fallen soldiers and airmen of Georgia for their unselfish and dedicated public
29 service to the citizens of this nation during Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring
30 Freedom and extend to the families of these soldiers and airmen their most profound
31 appreciation for the ultimate sacrifice made by their loved ones upon the altar of freedom.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
33 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the family of each fallen soldier or
34 airman named herein.
