- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Victor Herbert West; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Victor West was born on March 15, 1940, in Hall County, a beloved son of the
5 late Windom Lee and Edna Scofield West, Sr.; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
7 States Air Force, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Victor West was an active member of St. Paul
9 United Methodist Church; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to Mary Ann Nix West for 49 years and was
11 blessed with two remarkable children, Lee West and Kelley Foote; seven wonderful
12 grandchildren, Blake and Sadie Foote, Austin and Cheyenne West, and Daniel, Nicholas, and
13 Benjamin Cloud; and four adored great-grandsons; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he was a former president of the Fraternal Order of Police and retired from the
15 State Patrol after 29 years of service; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was a member of the American Association of State Troopers, the Masonic
17 Caledonia Lodge No. 121, and the American Legion; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
19 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
20 family and friends were admired by others; and

21 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
22 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
23 made this world a better place in which to live; and

24 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Victor West will long be remembered for
25 his love of family and friendship, and this loyal son, husband, father, grandfather,
26 great-grandfather, and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
