A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Louis Salerno, Kell High School's 2012 STAR Student; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most
3 important objective of the General Assembly; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Louis Salerno has shown by the example of his academic accomplishments that
5 the pursuit and attainment of scholastic success are within the reach of the students in this
6 state; and
- 7 WHEREAS, this remarkable scholar has earned distinction through his superlative
8 achievements at Kell High School, where he is a gifted student and has been selected as 2012
9 STAR Student; and
- 10 WHEREAS, to be selected as a STAR Student for a high school, a student must have
11 obtained the highest score in one administration of the three-part Scholastic Aptitude Test
12 and be in the top 10 percent or top ten students of his or her class; and
- 13 WHEREAS, each school has one STAR Student who in turn has the opportunity to choose
14 a STAR Teacher who has inspired and encouraged them throughout their high school career;

- 16 WHEREAS, Louis chose as his STAR teacher Kell High School educator Sara Griffin, who
17 provided support and guidance throughout the years and encouraged Louis to achieve his
18 utmost potential; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Louis has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness,
20 and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

21 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
22 bright and promising young citizen.

24 heartily commend Louis Salerno's spectacular scholastic endeavors, recognize him for being
