A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending David Walter Boggs; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, David Walter Boggs has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most
3 distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and David
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, for his Eagle project, David beautified the perimeter of the cemetery at Sixes
11 United Methodist Church, leading and coordinating the efforts of other scouts, church
12 members, friends, and family in almost 360 hours of work to clean up over two tons of trash,
13 cut down trees and branches, clear weeds and underbrush, and build two trash can holders
14 and a beautiful wall using old stones and blocks; and
- 15 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 641 and has demonstrated
16 great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America
17 program; and
- 18 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, David has truly exhibited a commitment to the
19 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
20 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
22 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend David Walter Boggs for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
25 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
26 rank of Eagle Scout.
