A RESOLUTION

1 Commending James Newton, Woodstock High School's 2012 STAR Student; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most
4 important objective of the General Assembly; and

5 WHEREAS, James Newton has shown by the example of his academic accomplishments that
6 the pursuit and attainment of scholastic success are within the reach of the students in this
7 state; and

10 as Woodstock High School's 2012 STAR Student; and

12 obtained the highest score in one administration of the three-part Scholastic Aptitude Test

15 a STAR Teacher who has inspired and encouraged them throughout their high school career;

17 WHEREAS, James chose as his STAR Teacher Woodstock High School educator Isabel
18 Mason, who provided support and guidance throughout the years and encouraged James to
19 achieve his utmost potential; and

20 WHEREAS, James has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness,
21 and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

22 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
23 bright and promising young citizen.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 heartily commend James Newton's spectacular scholastic endeavors, recognize him for being
