- 1 Recognizing and commending Emanuel County on its bicentennial; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on December 6 and 12 of 1812, the County of Emanuel was established by
- 3 legislative Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Emanuel County was created out of territory originally in parts of Montgomery
- 5 County and Bulloch County; and
- 6 WHEREAS, named in honor of former Georgia Governor David Emanuel, it was the 17th
- 7 county established in the State of Georgia; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Emanuel County is a leading producer of forest products; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Emanuel County is the home of East Georgia College, a unit of the University
- 10 System of Georgia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the City of Swainsboro was designed as the County Seat by the General
- 12 Assembly in 1822; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Emanuel County is situated at the crossroads of the great South, being at the
- 14 intersection of two national highways: United States Highway Number 1, running North
- 15 from the United States and Canada border to Key West, Florida; and United States Highway
- Number 80, from Tybee Island, Georgia, to the Pacific Ocean at San Diego, California; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the County of Emanuel has flourished as a center for religious, educational, and
- 18 cultural institutions; and
