## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the destructive and insidious nature of the United Nations Agenda 21; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the United Nations Agenda 21 is a comprehensive plan of extreme
- 4 environmentalism, social engineering, and global political control that was initiated at the
- 5 United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED) held in Rio de
- 6 Janeiro, Brazil, in 1992; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the United Nations Agenda 21 is being covertly pushed into local communities
- 8 throughout the United States of America through the International Council of Local
- 9 Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI) through local "sustainable development" policies, such as
- 10 Smart Growth, Wildlands Project, Resilient Cities, Regional Visioning Projects, and other
- "Green" or "Alternative" projects; and

- way of life of private property ownership, single-family homes, private car ownership and
