A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Mr. James "Moby" Carney on his induction into the Georgia
2 Radio Hall of Fame and the Country DJ Hall of Fame; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on October 15, 2011, Mr. James "Moby" Carney was inducted into the Georgia
4 Radio Hall of Fame and on February 21, 2012, he was inducted into the Country DJ Hall of
5 Fame at the Country Radio Broadcasters' Seminar in Nashville, Tennessee; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Carney earned the nickname "Moby" at the age of 12 and has been known
7 as Moby in the Morning since 1981; and

8 WHEREAS, a native of Crossville, Tennessee, Mr. Carney began his prestigious career in
9 radio at the age of 15 with WCSV in Crossville before attending Belmont College; and

10 WHEREAS, he has been entertaining radio fans in Tennessee, Tampa, Dallas, Houston, and
11 Atlanta for 25 years; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Carney has been a morning staple for Atlanta's KICKS 101.5 FM listeners
13 for the past ten years as the country station's morning disc jockey; and

14 WHEREAS, a five-time winner of Billboard's Major Market Country Morning Show of the
15 Year, Mr. Carney has earned two nominations for Major Market Morning Show of the Year
16 by the Country Music Association and the title of Major Market DJ of the Year from the
17 Academy of Country Music; and

18 WHEREAS, his "Moby in the Morning" radio show was syndicated in 30 towns across the
19 United States in the 1990's and today he is the president of Moby Enterprises and the creator
20 of "The Biggest Small Town in America" radio network which can be heard in Tennessee,
21 West Virginia, Missouri, and Georgia; and

22 WHEREAS, a resident of Roswell, Georgia, Mr. Carney is united in love and marriage to his
23 wife, Mary Beth, and has been blessed with two children, Jonah and Grace; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Carney is among the best radio personalities in the State of Georgia, and
25 his induction into the Georgia Radio Hall of Fame as well as the Country DJ Hall of Fame
26 is an honor befitting of his talent and success.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
28 recognize Mr. James "Moby" Carney for his incredible career in radio and congratulate him
29 upon his recent induction into the Georgia Radio Hall of Fame and the Country DJ Hall of
30 Fame.
