A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 12-5-51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to civil
- 2 liability for violations of water pollution provisions, so as to require violators to pay for the
- 3 costs of third-party monitoring; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Code Section 12-5-51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to civil liability
- 7 for violations of water pollution provisions, is amended by adding a new subsection to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 "(c) In addition to any liability imposed pursuant to subsection (b) of this Code section,
- any person who intentionally causes or permits any toxic, corrosive, acidic, caustic, or
- bacterial substance or substances to be spilled, discharged, or deposited in the waters of this
- 12 state, except by providential cause, in amounts, concentrations, or combinations harmful
- to the public health, safety, or welfare, or to animals, birds, or aquatic life, shall be required
- 14 to pay the full cost of external third-party monitoring for a period of time determined by
- the director; provided, however, that such time period shall not exceed two years. The
- department shall promulgate any rules and regulations necessary to implement and
- 17 administer this subsection."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
