### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the need to preserve the sovereignty of a federal corporation to engage in certain  
2 commercial activities within the confines of Baldwin County, Georgia; and for other  
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, it is of considerable importance to preserve the sovereignty of a federal  
5 corporation and to allow such corporation to engage in certain commercial activities within  
6 the confines of Baldwin County, Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, it is of further importance that such federal corporation have the ability to  
8 contract with nonfederal corporations and enter into a joint venture with Wills Creek  
9 Management Incorporated, Baldwin County, Georgia, the State of Georgia, and others; and

10 WHEREAS, it is also imperative that the federal corporation maintain its federal corporation  
11 independence and sovereignty while entering into a joint venture with Wills Creek  
12 Management Incorporated, an Alabama corporation, whereby both organizations may  
13 develop and manufacture green energy fuels; and

14 WHEREAS, the source of such green energy fuels is from a wood chips process developed  
15 by Cello Energy of Baldwin County, Alabama; and

16 WHEREAS, these entities may construct other commercial enterprises on property owned  
17 by said joint venture partners at the discretion of the joint venture partners, and may be  
18 approved by the governing body of Baldwin County, Georgia.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body recognize the need to preserve the sovereignty of a federal  
21 corporation to engage in certain commercial activities within the confines of Baldwin  
22 County, Georgia.
