- 1 Commending the Forest Park Teen Council and inviting its members to be recognized by the
- 2 House of Representatives; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Forest Park Teen Council is an organization that promotes interest in
- 4 activities and fellowship, develops leadership, and provides opportunities for members to
- 5 become better acquainted, discuss problems, share ideas and skills, work along with city
- 6 leaders, plan city activities, and share city responsibilities; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Forest Park Teen Council was officially formed in 2008 by Mayor Pro
- 8 Tempore Sparkle K. Adams with a group of students from Forest Park and began to thrive
- 9 in 2009; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in January of 2010, students from Forest Park Middle School, Babb Middle
- 11 School, Forest Park High School, and Forest Park Street School were referred to Mayor Pro
- 12 Tempore Adams to run for such offices as Teen Mayor, Councilperson, Finance Director,
- 13 and City Attorney; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the student body elected 47 students to serve in these capacities during an
- 15 election in February of 2010, and the teen council began holding meetings on the second
- 16 Tuesday of every month, which eventually increased to the second and fourth Tuesdays of
- each month; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the Forest Park Teen Council participated in the annual Keep Forest Park
- 19 Beautiful Clean Up in 2009, 2010, and 2011, assisted in planting the city's first community
- 20 garden in 2010, and were recognized at the Black History Month Celebration, "Rising on the
- 21 Southside," in 2011; and
- 22 WHEREAS, active in the community, the Forest Park Teen Council participated in the
- 23 Clayton County Board of Health's Teen Summit, completed and graduated from the Forest

24 Park Police Department's cadet program, attended Neighborhood Watch and Forest Park City

- 25 Council meetings, conducted a mock trial focusing on bullying with Judge Allison Pitts, and
- 26 assisted with the 5K Fun Run and the Forest Park Kiwanis Club during its semiannual
- 27 pancake breakfast; and
- 28 WHEREAS, the Forest Park Teen Council members support and encourage each other to
- 29 participate in personal growth opportunities, such as career focus workshops, communicating
- 30 orally and in writing seminars, and other educational opportunitites; and
- 31 WHEREAS, through its many initiatives, the Forest Park Teen Council has distinctively
- 32 served the community and its young citizens.
- 33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 34 the members of this body commend the efforts of the members of the Forest Park Teen
- 35 Council to make their community a better place to live and invite them to be recognized by
- 36 the House of Representatives at a date and time designated by the Speaker of the House of
- 37 Representatives.
