

The House Committee on Ways and Means offers the following substitute to HB 334:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 exemptions from sales and use tax, so as to provide a new exemption with respect to certain
3 sales of eligible food and beverages to a qualified food bank; to provide an effective date;
4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from
8 sales and use tax, is amended by revising subparagraph (A) of paragraph (57.1) as follows:
9 "(57.1)(A) From July 1, ~~2006~~ 2012, until June 30, ~~2010~~ 2015, sales of food and food
10 ingredients to a qualified food bank."

11 **SECTION 2.**

12 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012.

13 **SECTION 3.**

14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
