4 for the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the

5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mrs. Crawford earned a bachelor's degree from Paine College and a master's

7 degree from Indiana University and dedicated 38 years to uplifting the lives of students

- 9 WHEREAS, upon her retirement from the Richmond County School System in 1977, Mrs.
- 10 Crawford founded the Shiloh Comprehensive Community Center, where she served for 30

11 years as founding executive administrator; and

WHEREAS, her contributions to education and her community have been recognized with numerous honors and accolades, including the Jefferson Award for Outstanding Service from WJBF-TV, Humanitarian of the Year Award from University Hospital, Good Samaritan Award from the St. Joseph Foundation, Anna Eleanor Roosevelt Award from Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, and a Women of Distinction Award from the Girl Scouts of America; and

- 17 WHEREAS, a resident of Augusta, Georgia, Mrs. Crawford is a long-time supporter of Paine
- 18 College, serves as a charter member of the Presidents Club, has been selected as one of the
- 19 Distinguished Alumni, and assisted in designing the school flag; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Mrs. Crawford has lived on State Route 4 in Richmond County for over 45
- 21 years, where she has attended Williams Memorial CME Church and dedicated her time to
- 22 improving the lives of others in the community; and

- 23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of
- 24 this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
- 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL

26 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 4 in Richmond County from

27 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive Boulevard to State Route 104/Riverwatch Parkway is

- 28 dedicated as the Ruth B. Crawford Highway.
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
- 30 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Ruth B. Crawford Highway.
- 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 32 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Mrs. Ruth B. Crawford and
- 33 to the Department of Transportation.
