A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Carrollton High School for being named an Advanced
2 Placement Honor School; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Carrollton High School has been named an Advanced Placement Honor School
4 by the Georgia Board of Education for the second consecutive year, winning both times for
5 its AP science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) program; and

6 WHEREAS, Carrollton High School won awards for both years for AP STEM School and
7 AP STEM Achievement School; and

8 WHEREAS, the STEM School award is based on student testing in two AP math and two
9 AP science courses, while the STEM Achievement School award means that at least 40
10 percent of the AP math and science exams earned a score of a 3.0 or higher, based on a scale
11 of 5.0; and

12 WHEREAS, AP classes offer rigorous college-level learning opportunities for high school
13 students who gain the ability to receive college credits through exams administered by the
14 College Board; and

15 WHEREAS, the program at Carrollton High School was started by Jason Mundorf, who has
16 since been promoted to Carrollton Middle School principal; and

17 WHEREAS, the STEM teachers include Kasey Austin, William Melton, and Kristi
18 Bradford-Hunt; and

19 WHEREAS, the STEM program has partnered with Southwire Company and the Southwire
20 Engineering Academy, which has expanded the program and given students the opportunity
21 for Southwire internships; and

22 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia takes great pride in the diligent study and preparation taken
23 by the students of Carrollton High School and looks forward in anticipation to the great
24 achievements this school will accomplish in the future.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
26 commend Carrollton High School on being named an Advanced Placement Honor School
27 and recognize the excellent contributions of the students and staff in making their school
28 superior.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
30 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Carrollton High School.
