

House Bill 1063 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to create and establish the Troup County Airport
2 Authority," approved March 23, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 3387), so as to change the
3 membership of the authority; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 An Act entitled "An Act to create and establish the Troup County Airport Authority,"
7 approved March 23, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 3387), is amended by revising Section 6 as
8 follows:

9 "SECTION 6.

10 **Members of Authority and Terms of Office.**

11 On and after July 1, 2012, the Authority shall be composed of seven members, each of whom
12 shall be a resident of the county. The board of commissioners of the county shall appoint
13 three of the members; the governing body of the City of LaGrange, Georgia, shall appoint
14 two of the members; the governing body of the City of West Point, Georgia, shall appoint
15 one of the members; and the governing body of the City of Hogansville, Georgia, shall
16 appoint one of the members. The members initially appointed by the board of
17 commissioners of the county shall serve for five years; the members initially appointed by
18 the governing body of the City of LaGrange shall serve for four years; the members initially
19 appointed by the governing body of the City of West Point shall serve for three years; and
20 the members initially appointed by the governing body of the City of Hogansville shall serve
21 for two years. Thereafter, the members shall be appointed by the respective appointing
22 authorities to terms of five years. Members shall serve until their respective successors are
23 appointed and qualified. The terms of the members serving on June 30, 2012, shall end on

24 July 1, 2012; provided, however, that such members may be reappointed as provided in this
25 section.

26 **SECTION 2.**

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
