## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

An Act entitled "An Act to create and establish the Troup County Airport Authority,"
approved March 23, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 3387), is amended by revising Section 6 as
follows:

## Members of Authority and Terms of Office.

11 On and after July 1, 2012, the Authority shall be composed of seven members, each of whom 12 shall be a resident of the county. The board of commissioners of the county shall appoint 13 three of the members; the governing body of the City of LaGrange, Georgia, shall appoint two of the members; the governing body of the City of West Point, Georgia, shall appoint 14 one of the members; and the governing body of the City of Hogansville, Georgia, shall 15 appoint one of the members. The members initially appointed by the board of 16 commissioners of the county shall serve for five years; the members initially appointed by 17 the governing body of the City of LaGrange shall serve for four years; the members initially 18 appointed by the governing body of the City of West Point shall serve for three years; and 19 the members initially appointed by the governing body of the City of Hogansville shall serve 20 for two years. Thereafter, the members shall be appointed by the respective appointing 21 22 authorities to terms of five years. Members shall serve until their respective successors are appointed and qualified. The terms of the members serving on June 30, 2012, shall end on 23

- 24 July 1, 2012; provided, however, that such members may be reappointed as provided in this
- 25 section.
