A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending SFC Wade Chaffin of the Georgia State Patrol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Georgia State Patrol is a highly regarded agency by the citizens of the state
3 and by local government officials as officers of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the
4 sound principles of law enforcement; and

6 who attempted to kidnap seven-year-old Brittney Baxter; and
- 7 WHEREAS, SFC Wade Chaffin received a picture of the suspect from Officer Alexander of
8 the Bremen Police Department and conducted a traffic stop with Chief Scott Worthy of the
9 Tallapoosa Police Department; and
- 10 WHEREAS, without the alertness of SFC Wade Chaffin, the suspect would have been
11 successful in his attempt to flee the city; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that this body recognize the extraordinary
13 accomplishments of SFC Wade Chaffin of the Georgia State Patrol.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 commend the actions and selfless dedication of SFC Wade Chaffin and the Georgia State
16 Patrol.
